Welcome to Keeneland's 2016 November Breeding Stock Sale

eeneland has cataloged 4,762 horses for its world-renowned 2016 November Breeding Stock Sale, to be held Nov. 8-20. In 2015, the November Sale sold the world's highest-priced Thoroughbred at public auction for the year and registered a North American record price for a weanling for the second consecutive year.

"Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale is the largest sale of its kind in the world and is remarkable because of the unparalleled diversity and depth in its offerings," Keeneland Vice President of Racing and Sales Bob Elliston said. "Breeders from around the world will be here to obtain broodmares and broodmare prospects to add to or establish their programs, while others from an equally wide range of locations will set their sights on the sale's weanlings and horses of racing age."

Among the quality individuals featured in the 2016 November Sale are such Grade 1 stakes-quality mares as champion **Stellar Wind, Celestine, Lady Eli, My Conquestadory** (in foal to Tapit), **Paola Queen, Peace and War** (in foal to Tapit), **Personal Diary, Street Fancy and Secret Gesture (GB)** (in foal to War Front).

The 2016 November Sale also will include the dispersals of Ernie Semersky and Dory Newell's Conquest Stables, for which Lane's End will serve as agent; Marc Ferrell's VinMar Farm (St. George Sales, agent); and Jim Eigel's Rosemont Farm (Trackside Farm, agent).

Claiborne Farm will consign the Phipps Stable's 11-horse reduction, comprising fillies and mares from some of racing's most productive families. Among the offerings are Breeders' Cup Distaff (G1) winner Pleasant Home, in foal to Orb; Satisfaction, a halfsister to Grade 1 winner Dancing Forever and from the immediate family of champion Heavenly Prize, in foal to Point of Entry; graded stakes-placed Sea Island, a full sister to Grade 2 winner Sightseeing, in foal to Hard Spun; Secret Agenda, a 3-year-old daughter of Malibu Moon out of champion Smuggler; and Sound the Trumpets, a 3-year-old filly out of multiple Grade 1 winner My Flag and a half sister to champion Storm Flag Flying.

The November Sale also will feature a number of top-quality weanlings, including siblings to such champions and Grade/Group



1 winners as Songbird, Catch a Glimpse, Honor Code, Judy the Beauty, Sweet Loretta and Caravaggio.

Horses of racing age will be offered on Monday, Nov. 14 and Tuesday, Nov. 15 and will feature the consignments of WinStar Racing, agent, and Mill Ridge Sales, agent, as well as horses from the Conquest Stables dispersal. Among the 2016 stakes winners sold at the November Sale are Grade 1 winners **Haveyougoneaway** and **Photo Call (IRE)** and Grade 3 winners **Barbados** and **Scuba**.

Horses cataloged to the 2016 November Sale include 2,287 broodmares and broodmare prospects, 1,836 weanlings, 544 horses of racing age and three stallions.

Take Charge Brandi Commands \$6 Million in 2015


Last year, the November Sale featured the \$6 million sale of champion Take Charge Brandi, who was the most expensive Thoroughbred sold at public auction anywhere in the world. A North American record price for a weanling was set at the sale for the second year in a row when a filly by War Front out of Grade 1 winner Take Charge Lady (Take Charge Brandi's second dam) sold for \$3.2 million.

This year, Grade 1 winners sold as weanlings at the November Sale are champion and Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands winner **Nyquist, Beach Patrol** (Secretariat), **Bradester** (Stephen Foster), **Cavorting** (Personal Ensign and Ogden Phipps), **Drefong** (Ketel One King's Bishop), **Mshawish** (Donn), **Sweet Loretta** (Spinaway), **Union Strike** (Del Mar Debutante) and **Yellow Agate** (Frizette).

Prominent Stallions Featured

Broodmares cataloged to the 2016 November Sale are in foal to 217 proven and exciting young stallions around the world and include the first mares in foal to 2015 Triple Crown and Breeders' Cup Classic (G1) winner American Pharoah, who entered stud this year. Mares are in foal to such other stallions as Bernardini, Bodemeister, Candy Ride (ARG), Curlin, Declaration of War, Distorted Humor, Empire Maker, Ghostzapper, Giant's Causeway, Gleneagles (IRE), Honor Code, Liam's Map, Malibu Moon, Medaglia d'Oro, More Than Ready, Orb, Palace Malice, Pioneerof the Nile, Shanghai Bobby, Speightstown, Tapit, Uncle Mo and War Front.

He returned to Fasig-Tipton as Vice President of Fasig-Tipton Appraisals and Director of Sales Administration prior to joining Keeneland in 1996 as Assistant Director of Sales to Rogers Beasley.

Russell represents Keeneland on the Sales Integrity Task Force, International Catalogue Standards Committee (NA) (ICSC),

International Grading and Race Planning Advisory Committee (IRPAC), and is Vice Chairman of the Society of International Thoroughbred Auctioneers (SITA). He is also on the board of the Grayson-Jockey Club Foundation.

In his position, Thornbury acts as liaison to consignor interests, cultivates relationships with horsemen in emerging racing markets, and serves as a member of the yearling inspection team.

Thornbury grew up on the farm owned by his father, John Thornbury, and partner Dr. Robert Copelan, where he was involved in training and farm management, and assisted in equine orthopedic surgery. Thornbury spent nearly 10 years at Airdrie Stud, owned by

Jesse Ullery | Sales Associate



The November Breeding Stock Sale is the world's premier Thoroughbred auction of its type in terms of total sales and average. The sale, conducted annually since 1944, includes broodmares, weanlings, horses of racing age, racing and broodmare prospects, stallions, stallion shares and seasons. With the exception of the early years and dispersals, yearlings have not been sold during November.

The 2015 November Sale immediately followed the Breeders' Cup World Championships at Keeneland.

Champion and broodmare prospect Take Charge Brandi sold for \$6 million to be the most expensive Thoroughbred sold at public auction in the world in 2015.



Background: At Keeneland's 2015 November Breeding Stock Sale, Craig and Holly Bandoroff's Denali Stud sold 70 horses for a grand total of \$7,522,800. At \$3 million, Denali's toppriced horse was Grade

1 winner Photo Call (IRE), a daughter of Galileo (IRE) who sold to Crupi's New Castle. For owner Teresa Viola Racing Stables this year, Photo Call won the First Lady (G1) over champion Tepin during Keeneland's Fall Meet.

Photo Call (IRE) was the third highest-priced horse at the November Sale.

Craig Bandoroff was a jockey in New Jersey in the early 1970s until a spill at Garden State Park in 1974 left him without the use of his right arm, forcing him to explore other career paths within the industry. The Bandoroffs each gained experience working in various bloodstock and sales capacities, and in 1990 they opened Denali Stud. "Denali" is derived from the name given by the Eskimos to Mt. McKinley and means "the great one." Today, Denali covers 700 acres.

In the late 1990s, Bob Lewis and his wife, Beverly, sent their champion racemare Serena's Song to Denali when she was retired. Denali has sold several of Serena Song's offspring, including Group 1 winner Sophisticat, by Storm Cat, for \$3.4 million at the 2000 Keeneland July Selected Yearling Sale; Grade 2 winner Harlington, by Unbridled, for \$2.8 million at the 2003 Keeneland September Yearling Sale; and Colourful Score, a colt by Storm Cat, for \$3.5 million, at the 2005 September Sale.

Among Denali's achievements at Keeneland sales are two milestones from the November Sale. In 1998, Denali recorded its first seven-figure sale when it sold the Seattle Slew mare Calendar Lady, in foal to Mr. Prospector, for \$1.1 million to Reynolds Bell Jr., agent. In 2008, Denali Stud, agent, sold future champion Uncle Mo as a weanling to Moon Bloodstock for \$160,000.

Eaton Sales

Background: Eaton Sales Inc. is owned by Reiley McDonald, who purchased the sales agency from its founder, the late Lee Eaton, in the 1990s.

At the 2015 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, Eaton sold 72 horses for a grand total of \$14,869,000. Among them was the sale's highest-priced weanling, a daughter of War Front out of multiple Grade 1 winner

Take Charge Lady sold to Whisper Hill Farm for \$3.2 million. Eaton's two other seven-figure sellers also were weanling fillies: a daughter of Tapit-Refugee sold to Crupi's New Castle for \$1.3 million and a daughter of Galileo

(IRE)-Untouched Talent sold to Hunter Valley Farm for \$1.2 million.

In 2004, Eaton Sales, agent, purchased Take Charge Lady, a four-time Keeneland graded stakes winner in foal to Seeking the Gold, for \$4.2 million at the November Sale. From Take Charge Lady, Eaton bred Grade 1 winner Take Charge Indy, a colt by A.P. Indy colt, and 2013 champion 3-year-old male Will Take Charge, a colt by Unbridled's Song.

McDonald, a Maryland native, has a degree in animal sciences from Cornell University. He worked at various Maryland race tracks as an exercise rider and assistant trainer. McDonald was an officer at another Thoroughbred auction house prior to buying Eaton Sales. He is a Keeneland Director.

Eaton Sales served as agent for the dispersal of the W.T. Young family's Overbrook Farm, which in 2009-2010 sold 205 horses for \$38,606,000. At the time, the dispersal was the second largest in Keeneland sales history. It is now third behind the Edward P. Evans Spring Hill Farm dispersal, which sold 221 horses for \$62,364,000 million in 2011-2012, and the Nelson Bunker Hunt dispersal, which sold 580 horses for \$46,912,800 in 1988.

Successful horses Eaton Sales, agent, has sold as weanlings at the November Sale include two future Breeders' Cup winners: 2014 Juvenile Turf (G1) winner Hootenanny, purchased in 2012 by Winding Oaks Farm

for \$120,000 in 2012, and 2008 Filly and Mare Turf (G1) winner Forever Together, sold in 2004 to Alistair Roden Bloodstock for \$30,000.

Eaton Sales sold 2016 Grade 1 winner Cavorting to Stonestreet Stables for \$360,000 when she was a weanling at the 2012 November Sale.

Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency

Background: The leading consignor at Keeneland's 2015 November Breeding Stock Sale, Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency sold 97 horses for \$28,392,700. Among them was the auction's highest-priced horse, champion Take Charge Brandi, at \$6 million, the most paid for a Thoroughbred at public auction anywhere in the world last year.

Sikura not only sold Take Charge Brandi on behalf of owner Willis D. Horton, he bought her in the name of Hill 'n' Dale Equine.

Hill 'n' Dale sold a total of eight horses that brought seven figures or more at the 2015 November Sale, including two weanlings by War Front by \$2.6 million and \$2 million.

Sikura, a Keeneland Director, was mentored by his father, John Sikura, Jr., a Canadian entrepreneur and founder of Hill 'n' Dale Farm in Ontario. The younger Sikura grew up attending the sales and races with his father, and he

learned the business while working at Hill 'n' Dale's Kentucky division in the 1980s.

Following the death of his father in 1994, Sikura began to build the Kentucky farm into a prominent breeding and sales operation. Hill 'n' Dale encompasses 1,300 acres and stands 14 stallions, including Curlin, Midnight Lute and Stormy Atlantic. The farm is the final resting place of 1977 Triple Crown winner and leading sire Seattle Slew.

At the 2007 November Sale, Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, agent for Swettenham Stud, sold the highest-priced horse in the sale's history – Playful Act (IRE) – for \$10.5 million. The amount is the third-highest price continued on page 22

A lifelong horseman, the elder Farish bought his first Thoroughbred at Keeneland's 1963 September Yearling Sale. Since then, he has campaigned more than 165 stakes winners and bred more than 300 stakes winners, including Horses of the Year Mineshaft (2003) and A.P. Indy (1992). Farish received the Eclipse Award as leading breeder in 1992 and 1999. He has served on Keeneland's Board of Directors since 1985. In October 2006, he succeeded James E. (Ted) Bassett III as a Keeneland Trustee.

On Oct. 8, Farish received the Keeneland Gold Bowl in recognition of his 24th graded stakes win at the track when Irish Jasper won the Thoroughbred Club of America (G2).

Bill Farish's involvement in the industry includes serving as Chairman of the Board of Breeders' Cup Ltd. He also races horses and in 2005 founded Woodford Racing LLC, a partnership that includes friends and others he has introduced to Thoroughbred racing.

Lane's End handled the highest-grossing Thoroughbred dispersal in North American history as agent for the Edward P. Evans Spring Hill Farm dispersal. The dispersal sold 221 horses for \$62,364,000 at Keeneland sales in 2011-2012.

Lane's End also was agent for the Complete Dispersal of Saud bin Khaled's Palides Investments N.V., Inc. in 2011. The dispersal sold 40 horses for \$17,926,500 at Keeneland's September Sale.

In 2013, Lane's End was agent for the Complete Dispersal of E. Paul Robsham Stables LLC. The dispersal sold 24 horses for \$12,174,000 including the November Sale's \$4 million sale-topper, Awesome Maria. M.V. Magnier purchased the Grade 1-winning mare in foal to Giant's Causeway.

Last year, Lane's End sold 158 horses for \$12,810,200 at the November Sale. At \$1.6 million, its high seller was graded stakes winner Colonial Flag in foal to Tapit.

Background: In 2014, Paramount Sales consigned the top-priced horse to Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale. She was Aloof (IRE), a daughter of Galileo (IRE) in foal to War Front purchased by Mandy Pope's Whisper Hill Farm for \$3.9 million. Aloof was among the 110 horses Paramount sold for \$8,447,000.

At the 2015 November Sale, Paramount sold 107 horses for \$7,801,300. At \$500,000, its high seller was a weanling colt by Tapit who is a half-brother to Grade 1 winner Princess of Sylmar. He was purchased by Hunter Valley Farm.

Paramount was founded by Irishmen Pat Costello and Gabriel Duignan in 2001. Costello moved to Central Kentucky in the early 1980s, first developing and managing and Crescent Hill Farm. From there he opened Drumkenny Farm, a full-service boarding operation.

Duignan came to the U.S. in the mid-1980s, first working for Circle O Farm and later

managing Ironwood Farm in Western Kentucky. In 2001, he was named President of Castleton-Lyons near Lexington. Two years later, Duignan started his own full-service operation, Foxtale Farm.

Costello and Duignan first became partners when they created a successful pinhooking operation called "The Lads."

Paramount has consigned other high-priced horses to the November Sale. In 2006, Paramount, agent for Ballymacoll Stud Farm, sold the weanling Isla Canela for \$2.4 million. The daughter of Gone West is out of Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf (G1) winner Islington (IRE).

In 2010, Paramount Sales consigned eventual Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf winner George Vancouver to the November Sale. The weanling colt was purchased by D.M.I. for \$450,000.

Background:Taylor Made Sales Agency has ranked as the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale's leading consignor 18 times since 1990. Last year, the operation was the sale's second-leading consignor when it sold 228 horses for \$21,855,800 led by Grade 1 winner Hard Not to Like, purchased by DATTT Farm for \$2.2 million.

Taylor Made's other two seven-figure sellers at the 2015 November Sale were Canadian champion Spring in the Air, sold for \$1.65 million to Nawara Stud/Hugo Merry Bloodstock, agent, and Grade 1 winner Sunset Glow, sold to Pursuit of Success for \$1,375,000.

In 1976, Taylor Made was founded as a boarding operation by Duncan Taylor, the eldest son of noted horseman Joe Taylor who was 19 years old at the time. Joe Taylor, an acknowledged authority on Thoroughbred breeding, developed John Gaines' Gainesway Farm into a leading stallion farm during his 40-year management.

Taylor Made quickly evolved into a full-service breeding and sales facility. Joining Duncan, a Keeneland Director who is Taylor Made's president and CEO in its operation, are his brothers Ben (vice president of stallions), Frank (vice president of boarding) and Mark (vice president of marketing and public sales operations). Pat Payne (vice president of sales) also is a partner.

Represented by its first Keeneland consignment in 1978, Taylor Made, according to its website, has sold more than \$1.6 billion in Thoroughbreds. Future champions sold at Keeneland's September Yearling Sale are Anees, Farda Amiga and Ashado. Sold as a yearling for \$170,000, Ashado brought \$9 million, a Keeneland record for a broodmare prospect, when Taylor Made consigned her to the 2005 November Sale. The amount is the seventh-highest price ever paid for a horse at any Keeneland sale.

Among the horses Taylor Made has consigned as weanlings to the November Sale are 2001 Breeders' Cup Distaff (G1) winner Unbridled Elaine. In 1998, R.J. Devenport purchased the filly for \$230,000.

Background: In 2015, Calumet Farm added significantly to its bloodstock holdings by purchasing 71 horses for \$8,717,000 at Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale. Calumet bought more horses than any other buyer at the November Sale and was the sale's second-leading buyer by total amount spent.

At \$575,000, Calumet's highest-priced purchase at the sale was Grade 2 winner Teammate, who was in foal to Candy Ride (ARG).

Since 2012, successful businessman Brad Kelley has overseen Calumet, one of the most famous horse farms in North America and Keeneland's neighbor. In May 2013, Nicole Russo of *Daily Racing Form* described Calumet's notable history:

"Calumet has lived through a number of transformations, morphing from a Standard-bred facility into an elite Thoroughbred nursery as it passed through the Wright family, campaigning two homebred Triple Crown winners, and, decades later, surviving an episode of bankruptcy. Today, the farm is in the hands of Kelley, a deeply private billionaire with a passion for racing."

Among Kelley's racing success under the Calumet banner is winning the 2013 Preakness (G1) with Oxbow, who now stands at Calumet. In 2011, Eddie Kane, agent for Kelley's Bluegrass Hall LLC, paid \$250,000 for

the son of Awesome Again at Keeneland's September Yearling Sale.

Racing in the name of Kelley's Bluegrass Hall LLC, Hightail won the 2012 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint. Hightail is another graduate of the 2011 September Sale. D. Wayne Lukas trained Hightail and Oxbow.

With Kelley at the helm, Calumet scored its first win at Keeneland during the 2014 Spring Meet.

Calumet is home to 14 stallions in Kentucky and three other stallions in Arkansas, Indiana and Ohio. Among them is champion and dual classic winner Smarty Jones, who stands in Kentucky.

Background: Coolmore's vast operation is headquartered in Fethard, County Tipperary, and also has farms in Kentucky at Ashford Stud near Versailles and in Australia at Hunter Valley in New South Wales. John Magnier, a longtime patron of Keeneland sales, is managing partner of Coolmore. His son, M.V. Magnier, has represented Coolmore at recent Keeneland sales.

At Keeneland's 2015 November Breeding Stock Sale, M.V. Magnier spent \$2.6 million on a weanling colt by War Front whose third dam is Racing Hall of Famer Serena's Song. The weanling is a half-brother to Grade 1 winner Honor Code and Grade 2 winner Noble Tune.

In 2014, Magnier paid \$3.6 million for Grade 3 winner Naples Bay, a half-sister to leading sire Medaglia d'Oro in foal to War Front, at the November Sale. In 2013, he signed the November Sale-topping \$4 million ticket on the multiple graded stakes-winning mare Awesome Maria, sold in foal to Giant's Causeway. She was consigned by Lane's End, Agent for the Complete Dispersal of E. Paul Robsham Stables LLC.

John Magnier, whose family was prominently associated with jumpers in Ireland, helped establish Coolmore as one of the world's leading stallion operations. In 1975, legendary trainer Vincent O'Brien tapped Magnier to manage Coolmore for O'Brien and his partner, Robert Sangster. Their association resulted in Coolmore's domination of the European classics during the late 1970s and 1980s.

Today, Coolmore Ireland stands such leading stallions as Galileo (IRE) and Danehill Dancer, while 2015 Triple Crown winner American Pharoah, Giant's Causeway and Uncle Mo are among the stallions at Ashford.

Coolmore also encompasses the famed Ballydoyle training yard, where Vincent O'Brien conditioned such champions as Sir Ivor, Nijinsky II, Alleged, Storm Bird and Sadler's Wells, and today serves as home base for Irish champion trainer Aidan O'Brien (no relation).

Either individually or in various partnerships, the Magniers, Tabor, and Smith have been represented by numerous Group or Grade 1 winners and champions in Europe and the U.S.

Crupi's New Castle

Background: A former leading trainer in New Jersey during his 30-year career, James "J.J." Crupi is a consignor and bloodstock adviser for a number of prominent owners.

At Keeneland, he was the leading buyer at the 2015 November Breeding Stock Sale and was among the leading buyers of the 2016 September Yearling Sale. Among the horses he bought at the November Sale was Grade 1

winner Photo Call (IRE) for \$3 million. On Oct. 8 at Keeneland, Photo Call defeated champion Tepin in the First Lady (G1) for owner Teresa Viola Racing Stables.

His other seven-figure acquisition last November was a \$1.3 million weanling filly by Tapit who is a half-sister to Grade 1 winners Executive privelege and Hoppertunity.

At this year's September Sale, Crupi acquired 44 yearlings for a total of \$9,700,000. Among his purchases was a \$1.2 million colt by Tapit out of Grade 1 winner Hooh Why, the session topper on the sale's second day.

In 1995, Crupi founded Crupi's New Castle Farm on the site of the Wolfson family's Happy Valley Farm. New Castle, which covers more than 200 acres, includes a six-furlong training track over which the Wolfsons' Triple Crown winner Affirmed trained.

Among the horses Crupi has been associated with is 2015 Las Vegas Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile (G1) winner Liam's Map; he led the continued on page 25

colt into Keeneland's Winner's Circle after the race. At the 2012 September Sale, Liam's Map sold to Crupi, agent for St. Elias Stables, for \$800,000.

A few races after the Dirt Mile, Stopchargingmaria, who also had trained at Crupi's farm, won the Breeders' Cup Distaff (G1).

Don Alberto Corp.

Background: Don Alberto Corp. represents the family who owns Chile's prominent Haras Don Alberto and purchased Vinery near Lexington, renaming it Don Alberto Farm. At last year's Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, Don Alberto bought five mares for \$1,005,000.

At \$480,000, Don Alberto's most expensive purchase was Patsy Boyne (IRE), a half-sister to Irish highweight High Chaparral (IRE) in foal to Scat Daddy.

Carlos Heller of Haras Don Alberto has been the buyer for the family at Keeneland. His family has business interests in the airline, retail, health, banking and television industries, and he is president of Club Hipico de Santiago, the historic

Thoroughbred race track in Chile. His late grandfather, Alberto Solari, began breeding Thoroughbreds some 30 years ago, and his mother, Liliani Solari, is the principal owner of Haras Don Alberto.

Haras Don Alberto is home to several hundred mares, Heller said, and recently has welcomed such Northern Hemisphere-based shuttle stallions as Mastercraftsman, No Nay Never, Stay Thirsty and War Command.

Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings

Background: Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings has acquired a number of broodmares and broodmare prospects at Keene-

land. One notable purchase took place at the 2015 November Breeding Stock Sale, where Stonestreet paid \$1.6 million for the Broken Vow mare Bella Jolie. A few days earlier, her son Runhappy won the TwinSpires Breeders' Cup Sprint (G1).

Among the other horses Stonestreet purchased at the sale was Comedy, dam of Grade 1 winner Taris in foal to Tapit, for \$1.5 million and the Tapit filly Royal Obsession for \$1,150,000.

Stonestreet represents the successful Thoroughbred operation founded by the late Jess Stonestreet Jackson and now operated by his widow, Barbara Banke.

Jess Jackson, who died in April 2011, and Barbara Banke built Jackson Family Wines into one of the world's most popular brands. In 2005, they established Stonestreet Farm on the former Buckram Oak Farm not far from Keeneland.

In December 2012, Banke acquired a breaking, training and rehab facility in Florida that was renamed the Stonestreet Training and Rehabilitation Center. In August 2013, she was elected to The Jockey Club. She is a Keeneland Director.

Stonestreet's racing achievements include campaigning 2007-2008 Horse of the Year Curlin, who stands at Hill 'n' Dale Farm, and 2009 Horse of the Year Rachel Alexandra, who resides at Stonestreet. In partnership with WinStar Farm, Stonestreet raced 2015 Toyota Blue Grass (G1) and 2014 Claiborne Breeders' Futurity (G1) winner Carpe Diem, who entered stud at WinStar this year.

Among Stonestreet runners in 2016 was multiple Grade 1 winner Cavorting, purchased for \$360,000 as a weanling at Keeneland's 2012 November Sale.

Stonestreet also has achieved success as a commercial breeder. At the 2008 Keeneland September Yearling Sale, Gainesway, agent for Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings LLC, sold the A.P. Indy filly Chimayo for \$3.1 million. The amount is the fifth-highest price ever paid for a filly at the sale.

At the same sale, Take Charge Brandi sold for \$6 million to be the highest-priced Thoroughbred sold at public auction anywhere in the world.

Pope's other notable acquisitions at the November Sale include the highest-priced horse sold at the 2014 auction. She spent \$3.9 million on Aloof (IRE), a daughter of Galileo (IRE) in foal to War Front.

At the 2016 Keeneland September Yearling Sale, Timber Town, agent, sold the resulting foal, a filly, to John Ferguson Bloodstock for \$900,000.

Another of Pope's notable purchases at Keeneland occurred at the 2013 November Sale when she bought two-time champion and Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint (G1) winner Groupie Doll for \$3.1 million. Groupie Doll raced twice more under Whisper Hill Farm ownership, finishing fourth in the Grade 1 Cigar Mile against males and drawing off to a dominant victory in the Grade 3 Hurricane Bertie in 2014.

Pope, who grew up riding hunters and jumpers, became interested in racing when she moved to Florida in 1980. She boards her broodmares in Kentucky and raises her young horses at Whisper Hill, which also is home to many retired Thoroughbreds.

Pope is co-owner of discount retailer Variety Wholesalers along with her brother Art. She also serves as vice chairman of the John William Pope Foundation, which works to improve the well-being of the citizens of North Carolina and the nation through the advancement of individual freedom and personal responsibility. The foundation, named for Pope's late father, makes grants to support public policy groups, educational institutions, humanitarian efforts, and the arts.

Background: Dallas resident Kenny Troutt has been a horseman for more than 20 years and an entrepreneur most of his life. The Illinois native established his first horse farm, Landview, in eastern Nebraska in the early 1980s. In 1988, he founded Excel Communications, a long-distance telephone service company that integrated the growing demand for telecommunications service with relationship marketing. As founder and chairman of Excel, Troutt used innovative business and marketing strategies that resulted in the meteoric rise of the corporation and its success as a publicly traded enterprise in 1996.

WinStar Farm, which is located near Keeneland, covers more than 1,800 acres. The farm includes a stallion operation and a training and rehab facility with a seven-furlong all-weather training track. WinStar's stallions include leading sires Distorted Humor, Tiznow, Pioneerof the Nile and Speightstown and will stand 2016 Preakness (G1) winner Exaggerator in 2017.

WinStar has enjoyed success at the track, campaigning such standouts as 2010 Kentucky Derby (G1) winner Super Saver; 2010 Belmont (G1) and 2011 Breeders' Cup Classic (G1) winner Drosselmeyer; and 2009

Saver is also on WinStar's stallion roster.

At last year's November Sale, WinStar acquired 10 horses for \$4.08 million. At

Dubai World Cup (G1) Well Armed. Super

At last year's November Sale, WinStar acquired 10 horses for \$4.08 million. At \$775,000, its most expensive acquisition was the Smart Strike mare Lucky Number in foal to Declaration of War.

WinStar Racing, agent, consigns a number of horses of racing age to the horses of racing age portion of the November Sale. Graduates include 2016 stakes winners Barbados and Plot Twist.

Background: Brothers Teruya, Katsumi and Haruya Yoshida are leading Japanese breeders and owners who are longtime patrons of Keeneland sales.

Their grandfather, Zenuske Yoshida, was one of the first Japanese to import Thoroughbreds from the U.S. on a major scale. He died in 1946, leaving the family business to his son Zenya Yoshida (their father) and his two brothers. Zenya Yoshida founded Shadai Farm on the island of Hokkaido in 1955

The Yoshida brothers operate Shadai Stallion Station. The farm was home to Racing Hall of Famer Sunday Silence, winner of the 1989 Kentucky Derby (G1), Preakness (G1) and Breeders' Cup Classic (G1). Among the stal-

lions it stands are leading sire Deep Impact, a son of Sunday Silence, and Japan Triple Crown winner Orfevre. Another is 2008 Peter Pan (G2) winner Casino Drive, a half-brother to Belmont (G1) winners Jazil and Rags to Riches.

Shadai acquired two fillies at Keeneland's 2015 November Breeding Stock Sale, spending \$550,000 for Grade 3 winner Munirah, by Kitten's Joy, and \$360,000 for Grade 2 Seduire, by Elusive Quality. Another notable purchase at the sale occurred in 2013 when Shadai paid \$1.3 million for Zealous Cat, who was in foal to Bernardini.

In 1994, Katsumi Yoshida began Northern Farm on Hokkaido. The farm is home to a number of broodmares that were extremely successful in the U.S. Among them is Horse of the Year Azeri, whom Katsumi Yoshida purchased in foal to Distorted Humor for \$2.25 million at the 2009 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale.

Last year, Katsumi Yoshida bought Grade 1 winner Don't Tell Sophia, in foal to Medaglia d'Oro, for \$1.2 million at the November Sale. His other recent acquisitions at the auction include Silver Bullet Moon, carrying a full sibling to Grade 1 winner Shakin It Up, in 2014; Grade 1 winner Diamondrella (GB), in foal to Distorted Humor for \$1.5 million, in 2013; Grade 1 winner Zazu, purchased for \$2.1 million in 2012; and Grade 1 winner Ticker Tape (GB), in foal to Giant's Causeway, for \$950,000 in 2011.

In 1995, Haruya Yoshida established Oiwake Farm. Among his purchases at Keeneland is Grade 1 winner and millionaire Unbridled Belle, in foal to Bernardini, for \$400,000 at the 2014 January Horses of All Ages Sale. He bought two other mares at the same sale: stakes winner Yonagucci, in foal to Bodemeister, for \$150,000 and broodmare prospect Celestial Cat for \$100,000.
