	Breeders' Cup, EBF and State-bred nominations due into their respective offices in order to appear in the sales catalog
TUE	SDAY, OCT. 14
First day to pull the following:	
	 X-rays to Repository: Must be taken within 15 days of sale date. X-rays, endoscopic videotapes and veterinary certificates must be on file in the Repository at least four days prior to sale date. Veterinarians need to reach out to awhalen@keeneland.com for directions on uploading x-rays into the repository.
SUNDAY, OCT. 19	
First day to pull the following:	
	All broodmares or broodmare prospects must have a Certificate of Reproductive Status on file stating "pregnant" or "suitable for mating" and be dated within 10 days of selling date. Certificate can be emailed to pmaley@keeneland.com
FRIDAY, OCT. 24	
	Original color Coggins emailed or turned in to mjohnson@keeneland.com • Coggins results must be dated within 12 months of the selling date and valid for at least two weeks after the selling date.
	EVA results emailed to mjohnson@keeneland.com • EVA results must be dated within 90 days of date of sale.
	All horses must be vaccinated against Equine Herpes Virus Type 1 (EHV-1) by a licensed veterinarian a minimum of fourteen (14) days and no more than one hundred and twenty (120) days prior to sale date. • Proof of vaccination date and product used must be emailed to mjohnson@keeneland.com
	Jockey Club Registration certificates due • Digital registration transferred to Keeneland Association, Inc. • Original registration certificates turned into Sales Office
	Consignor's Authorized Agent form emailed to pmaley@keeneland.com • Keeneland must have an owner's signature on file for every consigned horse in the sale • One partner's signature is sufficient for all partners • Form must be filled out completely and natorized (Docusign of

other Kentucky authorized electronic notary accepted)
