

2019 Keeneland College Scholarship Day Rules (Spring)

NON-INDUSTRY STUDENTS

- Students must be present at drawing on April 5, 2019 to win.
- One entry per student with valid school identification.
- Students must be enrolled **full-time** at a college, university, technical school, trade school or other such school that qualifies for federal aid.
- One scholarship will be awarded to any one winner. After verification, a check in the amount of \$1,000 will be forwarded to the school in the name of the school and the student. The same rules apply for the \$10,000 RunHappy scholarship.
- Decision of the officials at Keeneland and the Kentucky Thoroughbred Association will be final.

INDUSTRY STUDENTS

- Students must be present at drawing on April 5, 2019 to win.
- One entry per student with valid school identification.
- Students must be enrolled **full-time** at a college, university, technical school, trade school or other such school that qualifies for federal aid.
- College Student must be enrolled Full-Time and either work in the Thoroughbred Industry or have parents who work in the Thoroughbred Industry (Keeneland, Keeneland Hospitality, KTA, Horse Farm, Trainers, etc...)
- Decision of the officials at Keeneland and the Kentucky Thoroughbred Association will be final.

**For Races 1-9, both industry and non-industry students will be eligible for prize and scholarship drawings. For Race 10, only industry students will be eligible for prize and scholarship drawings.*
