

2021 Spring Meet Virtual Keeneland College Scholarship Day Rules

NON-INDUSTRY STUDENTS

- One entry per student.
- Students must be enrolled **full-time** at a college, university, technical school, trade school or other such school that qualifies for federal aid.
- One scholarship will be awarded to any one winner. After verification, a check in the amount of designated scholarship will be forwarded to the school in the name of the school and the student.
- Scholarships are eligible to all full time students in the United States while prizes will be limited those in the state of Kentucky.
- Decision of the officials at Keeneland and the Kentucky Thoroughbred Association will be final.

INDUSTRY STUDENTS

- One entry per student with valid school identification.
- Students must be enrolled **full-time** at a college, university, technical school, trade school or other such school that qualifies for federal aid.
- Students must either work in the Thoroughbred Industry or have parents who work in the Thoroughbred Industry (Keeneland, Keeneland Ambassador, Keeneland Hospitality, KTA, a horse farm, trainer, etc...)
- One scholarship will be awarded to any one winner. After verification, a check in the amount of designated scholarship will be forwarded to the school in the name of the school and the student.
- Scholarships are eligible to all full time students in the United States while prizes will be limited those in the state of Kentucky.
- Decision of the officials at Keeneland and the Kentucky Thoroughbred Association will be final.

**For Races 1-9, both industry and non-industry students will be eligible for prize and scholarship drawings. For Race 10, only industry students will be eligible for prize and scholarship drawings.*
