CAPE TOWN leaned in slightly at the start bumping lightly with LIL'S LAD, went up to stalk that one within easy striking distance four or five wide, loomed prominently for the drive but came up empty. IAN'S THUNDER saved ground to no avail. SOLID WOOD was bumped lightly at the start and gave way readily at the far turn.
