

Del Mar Handicapping Contest 2020

Red Mile Simulcasting will host handicapping contests on the last seven races at Del Mar on each Friday beginning Friday, July 17, and continuing through Friday, September 4.

The contest entry fee is \$20. Contestants will make a mythical \$2 win and \$2 place wager on one horse only in the first seven races at Del Mar. Management reserves the right to add races as necessary, and to adjust if Del Mar runs fewer than nine races. Contestants may wager on any seven races if some races are added.

Entries

- **Contestants must be at least 18 years old. (Entrants in the Tournament of Champions must be 21 years old or older.)**
- Entry fee will be \$20 with a maximum of three entries per person.
- Registration will be available at the Red Mile Programs stand, beginning at 4:30 PM each Friday.
- **Deadline for registration will be the post time for the third race at Del Mar at approximately 6:00 PM.**

General Information

- Full-time Keeneland employees, mutuel clerks and employees of United Tote and Keeneland Hospitality are ineligible to participate.
- **Owners and trainers with a horse running at Del Mar on the day of the contest are ineligible to enter the contest.**
- Contestants will use a swipe card and/or an identification number when making selections for the contest.
- There is a 20-1 "cap" on the win wager (\$42 maximum payoff) and a 10-1 "cap" on the place wager (maximum \$22 payoff).
- The contest is based on winnings only. A contestant may elect to not make a wager on any race but the \$4 cost for the contest wager does not stay in the account.
- Contestants can choose only one horse in each contest race and may not play any race more than once.
- If a Late Scratch occurs or a horse is declared a "non-starter" in any contest race, the contestant must return to the window to cancel the ticket and select another horse for the contest race. If a Late Scratch occurs or a horse is declared a "non-starter" and post time prevents the selection of an alternate horse or bet cancellation, the actual post time favorite will be substituted for the scratched horse.
- It is the contestant's responsibility to check all mutuel tickets before leaving the window. Discrepancies should be corrected immediately at the same window.
- Please keep your contest mutuel ticket receipts until the final standings have been declared official.

- If Del Mar should run four or more races that day, the weekly prizes will be awarded for the contest. If Del Mar should cancel racing or run three races or less, entry fees will be refunded and the contest cancelled.
- In the event of a tie among the winners, the prize for that place and the following place shall be combined and divided equally. If there is a tie for fifth, only the fifth place money is divided among those tied.
- OFFICIAL STANDINGS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS ARE AVAILABLE IN THE CONTEST AREA ONLY.
- The top ten percent of the qualifying contestants will be eligible to compete in the Tournament of Champions to be held in November. A contestant may qualify only one time for the Tournament of Champions. This does not affect cash prizes for the qualifying rounds.
- 100% of entry fees will be paid out in prize money.
- Red Mile Simulcasting reserves the right to amend these rules at any time.
- In all rulings, the decision of the contest coordinator is final.

*Estimated Prize Distribution (based on 100 entries)

1st Place	\$900
2nd Place	\$450
3rd Place	\$350
4th Place	\$200
5th Place	\$100

Prize money will be re-calculated and distributed based on the final count of paid entries.

In addition, in 2020 we are instituting a bonus program to reward our most consistent players. Beginning with the January 10th contests, points will be awarded to the top ten finishers each week (10 points for 1st, 9 for 2nd, etc.) and at the end of the season prior to the Tournament of Champions the following cash prizes will be awarded:
