

# Stonestreet Lexington Stakes (G3)

Sponsored by Stonestreet

37th Running • Spring • 1 1/16 miles • 3-year-olds

The Lexington first was contested by 2-year-olds during Keeneland's inaugural meeting in October 1936. The race was run as a handicap for 3-year-olds and older horses from 1938-1941. It returned to the stakes schedule in 1984 when officials elevated the Calumet Purse — an important allowance race for 3-year-olds — to an added-money event and renamed it the Lexington Stakes. Barbara Banke's Stonestreet began to sponsor the race in 2017, and the purse increased \$50,000 to \$200,000.
