Indian Summer Stakes History

2nd Running • Fall • 5 1/2 furlongs (turf) • 2-year-olds • 2018 Purse: \$200,000

The Indian Summer returned to the Keeneland stakes schedule during the 2018 Fall Meet as the track's 10th Breeders' Cup Challenge race. The stakes is a 5½-furlong race on the turf for 2-year-olds that awards the winner an automatic berth in the \$1 million Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint. Keeneland held the Indian Summer from 1991-1996 and 1998-2001 under different conditions (page 151).



Strike Silver came from next to last at the top of the stretch in the 12-horse field to win the Indian Summer by a neck.
