

# Shakertown Stakes (G2)

22nd Running • Spring • 5 1/2 furlongs (turf) • 3-year-olds and up

Shakertown, located 25 miles southwest of Lexington, is America's largest and most completely restored Shaker community and living museum. A national historic landmark, Shakertown also is known as Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill. The race was upgraded in 2016.
