32nd Running Of The Castle & Key Bourbon "Win and You're In Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Division" \$350,000 (Grade II) (Includes \$50,000 from KTDF)

FOR TWO YEAR OLDS By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$6,000 at time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$1,500 to enter and an additional \$1,500 to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed plus an additional \$50,000 KTDF for KTDF eligible horses. After payment of 1.25% to each owner of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining association purse will be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth. KTDF funds correspondingly divided providing a KTDF eligible horse finishes in an award position. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded or group stakes on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes at a mile or over, 4 lbs. The Castle & Key Bourbon has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge Races. The nominated winner of the Castle & Key Bourbon will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2022 running of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Division. The nominated winner will also be entitled to have pre-entry and entry fees waived for the 2022 Juvenile Turf or will receive a credit equal to the Juvenile Turf pre-entry and entry fee amount towards any other 2022 Breeders' Cup Championship race. All horses will be entitled to receive a travel stipend if traveling from a base located outside the state of Kentucky. To be eligible for the 2022 Breeders' Cup World Championships held at Keeneland on November 4 and 5, 2022, all horses must be pre-entered by noon (local standard time at the designated place of pre-entry) on Monday, October 24, 2022. Winner must be nominated by pre-entry deadline to receive Challenge rewards. All Breeders' Cup Challenge Races and Breeders' Cup World Championship races are to be run Lasix free and in accordance with Breeders' Cup Limited rules as they may be published from time to time. In the event a designated Breeders' Cup Challenge turf race is taken off the turf, due to unsafe racing conditions, the horse that wins the "off the turf" race will not receive an automatic qualifying position and will not receive the starting fees (the total of pre-entry and entry fees) to enter the Championships in the applicable Turf Division race; provided, however, that Breeders' Cup Limited may, at its option, reinstate the "Win and You're In" status of the "off the turf" race. The decision to take a Breeders' Cup Challenge Division turf race off the turf course is under the sole discretion of the racetrack/racing association, not Breeders' Cup Limited. All runners nominated to Challenge races are subject to out-of-competition testing by the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission and/or BCL. All Challenge winners are subject to out-of-competition testing conducted by the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission and/or BCL. Breeders' Cup Limited reserves the right in its sole discretion to postpone, discontinue, amend, or change the conditions of all or any part of the Breeders' Cup Challenge "Win & You're In" race program. The maximum number of starters for the Castle & Key Bourbon will be limited to twelve, with four also eligibles. If this race is transferred to the main track the field will be limited to fourteen. In the event the race overfills the starters will be determined at that time by horses that have finished first, second or third in a graded stakes, horses that have finished first, second or third in non-restricted stakes then condition preference. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). A Keeneland trophy cup will be presented to the owner of the winner.
