FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$2,500 to enter and an additional \$2,500 to start, with \$250,000 guaranteed plus an additional \$50,000 KTDF for KTDF eligible horses. After payment of 1.25% to each owner of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining association purse will be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth. KTDF funds correspondingly divided providing a KTDF eligible horse finishes in an award position. Weight: Three year olds, 122 lbs.; Older 124 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade I or II sweepstakes on the turf in 2022, allowed 2 lbs.; a graded sweepstakes in 2022 or \$90,000 on the turf since Christmas, 4 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Franklin will be limited to twelve with four also eligibles. If this race is transferred to the main track the field will be limited to fourteen. In the event that the race overfills the starters will be determined with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest non-restricted turf earnings in 2022. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). A Keeneland trophy cup will be presented to the owner of the winner.
