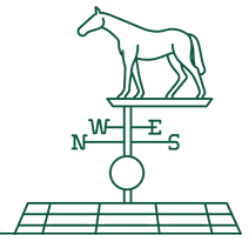


Guide to the 2022 Keeneland November Sale & Breeders' Cup



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Ship-In & Stabling

For Book 1 horses, when can barns be set-up?

Barn set-up can begin on Tuesday, Nov. 1. Please note that our Outside Maintenance team will be working in these barns to get them ready for the sale during this time.

For Session 1 horses, when can we ship-in?

You can begin shipping in Book 1 horses on Thursday, Nov. 3. You can also ship in horses the mornings of Friday, Nov. 4 and Saturday, Nov. 5. You must do so by 11 a.m. those days, and only through Gate 3, exiting through Gate 2.

For Session 2 horses, when can barns be set up and shipped into?

Consignors selling in Session 2 can set up and ship in prior to 11 a.m. on Saturday, Nov 5 with all trailers and vans entering through Gate 3 on Rice Road and exiting out of Gate 2 on Versailles Road. Keeneland will send communication to vaning companies outlining the routes.

The grounds will be open as usual beginning Sunday, November 6th for usual and customary move-in.

Once set-up, will there be adequate security to watch our barns, hay, straw, equipment, etc?

Yes. We will have significantly more security for all horses shipping during Breeders' Cup.

Where will Breeders' Cup horses be stabled?

All Breeders' Cup horses will be stabled at the Rice Road Training Center.

How will vans transport on and off the grounds?

All horse vans will enter through Gate 3 and exit through Gate 2 on Friday, Nov. 4 and Saturday, Nov. 5 before 11 a.m. All gates open on other days.

Parking & Moving About The Grounds

Where will consignors and sales staff park?

There will be designated parking on grounds that will include a parking area for buyers, consignors preferred parking, and consignor staff parking. Please see the Sales Parking Map for those designated parking areas.

How will buyers be able to travel onto Keeneland's sales grounds?

Buyers will have on-grounds parking as well. Keeneland will be distributing all passes the week of Breeders' Cup.

Will consignors, buyers, and sales staff be able to come and go easily?

Yes. The amount of vehicular traffic for the race days will be very limited with designated areas closest to the barn being set aside for buyers and consignors. All sales traffic should use Gate 3 off of Rice Road to access the campus.

Will veterinarians, blacksmiths and tack suppliers have access to the sales barns?

Yes, but they will need to be sure to secure a credential by Nov. 4. Their normal hang tags used for sales will NOT grant them access onto Keeneland grounds November 4th & 5th. Please contact mjohnson@keeneland.com to coordinate veterinarian parking.

Will our lunch caterers be able to attend to us?

Yes, lunch caterers will need to enter and exit through Gate 3 from Rice Road. We ask that you communicate in advance who will be delivering your food so that we can add them to an approved list with Gate 3 attendants. That information can be sent to mhunter@keeneland.com

Sales Pavilion + Grounds

Will the Pavilion be open, including the business office, sales counter and restaurant?

No – The Sales Pavilion and all related offices will not be open on Friday, Nov. 4 and Saturday, Nov. 5 but will open on Sunday.

Will the Repository be open?

The repository will be open Tuesday, Nov. 1– Thursday, Nov. 3 from 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. On Breeders' Cup days the side door to the repository will be open to drop items off. Remote viewing will be available Saturday, Nov. 5 and the repository will be open as normal starting Sunday, Nov. 6 at 7:00 a.m.

Will there be facilities for consignors and buyers to watch and bet the Breeders' Cup races?

Yes, the Track Kitchen will be set up as a wagering and entertainment area for consignors, buyers and sales staff to watch and wager on all Breeders' Cup races. We will also have food and drink offerings available in that area.
