All horses must have a negative Coggins test dated less than one year prior to date of arrival. This certificate must accompany the health certificate on arrival to Keeneland.

This inquiry includes information as to your character, general reputation, personal characteristics, and

mode of living, which may be applicable. You have the right to make a written request within a reasonable period of time for a complete and accurate disclosure of additional information concerning the nature and scope of the investigation.

Keeneland may televise or authorize or license the televising of certain horse racing to be conducted in its racing plant from time to time. Accordingly, it hereby reserves television rights, whether in connection with any race, preparations thereof, ceremonies or proceedings thereafter, or training at the track. This application is accepted on the condition that, if required, consent is hereby given, and the owner, jockey, trainer, groom and all other employees of the owner coming within the view of the television picture hereby agree to sign and deliver to Keeneland upon demand releases permitting such television and the exhibition thereof.
